Dr. Rajesh Raj is the recipient of the Dr. VKRV Rao prize in Economics for the year 2014 by the ISEC (Institute for Social and Economic Change), Bangalore, and ICSSR (Indian Council of Social Science Research), New Delhi, an honorary research fellow, SEED, University of Manchester, 2014-2017, visiting scholar, UNU-WIDER, Helsinki, Finland from March-May, 2020.

His publications include articles in reputed/high indexed journals such as small business economics, journal of comparative economics, Manchester school, international journal of educational development, oxford development studies, and European journal of development research, developing economies, and many others.

He interacted with the students, teaching and non-teaching members of the University.
